LICENSE BOND FOR TRANSIENT VENDORS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that _____

as principal and the undersigned surety, are held firmly bound unto the CITY OF MACON as obligee, in the penal sum of Five Thousand and 00/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States, for which payment, will and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, or heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS, the principal has applied to the CITY OF MACON, obligee, for a license as a transient vendor.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, that if the principal shall faithfully perform the duties of such license, and in all things comply with the laws of the United States and the State of Georgia and the ordinances, rules and regulations of the City of Macon pertaining thereto, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect from the date of issuance of the license until one (1) year thereafter.

This bond shall be payable to the City of Macon or anyone else suing in its name for their use for injuries or damages arising from dishonest or fraudulent conduct in the administration of the transient vendor business.

This bond may be terminated at any time by the surety upon sending notice in writing, by registered mail, to the Clerk of the City of Macon, City Hall, Macon, Georgia 31298 and at the expiration of thirty (30) days from the mailing of said notice, the liability of such surety is thereby terminated and cancelled; and provided further that nothing herein shall affect any right of liability which shall have accrued under this bond prior to the date of such termination.
