Know all men by these presents that _____ of _____ County, Georgia, as Principal, and the _____ as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Hancock County Department of Health of Hancock County, Georgia in the principal sum of TEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$10,000.00) DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the Hancock County Department of Health for which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, jointly and severally by this instrument.

Whereas, the said Principal has been or is about to be bonded to the Hancock County Department of Health to install or repair septic tanks, grease traps or place chemical toilets or service chemical toilets or pump or remove sewage in Hancock County.

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Principal shall in conduct of said business will and truly and faithfully observe all of the applicable regulations of the City of Sparta and the County of Hancock, and the State of Georgia, that are now or may hereafter be lawfully prescribed, and shall indemnify and save harmless any person for whom work may be done in the conduct of said business from all damages that may result from any defective work or from failure to complete any work done in the conduct of said business in accordance with the applicable regulations of the City of Sparta and the County of Hancock and State of Georgia, and shall save harmless and person for whom work may be done in conduct of said business from all claims for personal injuries the conduct of said business by the said Principal, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

It is a further condition of this obligation that it shall be cancelled as to all subsequent accidents of the Principal thirty (30) days after receipt by the Oblige of the Surety's written notice of cancellation.
