WHEREAS, the above named Principal has applied to Monroe County, Georgia for a license to engage in business at: (name & address of business) _____

as a Retailer of Wine, under the provisions of the Domestic Wines Act of 1935, GA. Laws 1935, page 492, (GA. Code Ann. 58-801 et seq.) and Taxation & Regulations of Manufacture and Sale of Wine Act of 1937, Ga. Laws of 1937 (Ga. Code Ann. 58-901 et seq.) for a period beginning _____ day of _____, _____, and ending December 31, _____, inclusive.

NOW THEREFORE, the conditions of this obligation is such that if a license is granted to the said _____, and if such licensee shall during the life of said license, promptly pay to Monroe County, Georgia, for its use all sums which may become due by said Principal to Monroe County, Georgia, as taxes, license fees, or otherwise, by Monroe County, Georgia, in the collection of any amount due Monroe County, Georgia, the amount of expense to be determined by the County Commissioners but not to exceed Two-Hundred Fifty Dollars, and shall faithfully comply with all laws, rules, and regulations governing the sale of Wine beverages as required by the aforesaid Act, and such other conditions as Monroe County, Georgia, may by ordinance, rules, regulations, and policy require, then this bond shall be void; otherwise, to remain in full force and shall be construed as a forfeiture bond.

This bond shall be in force for the aforesaid period of said Principal's Wine beverage license. It is understood and agreed that this bond must be continued by continuation certificate signed by the Surety, unless the bond expressly declares that it is one of a continuing nature.

It is further understood and agreed that if the Surety shall so elect, this bond may be canceled by giving sixty (60) days notice in writing to the County Clerk of Monroe County Commissioners of Forsyth, Georgia.
