HOUSE MOVER'S INDEMNITY BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

as Principal, and _____, as Surety, are jointly and severally bound to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and/or any private person or corporation residing within the municipal limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in the penal sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00), lawful money of the United States of America, for the payment of which well and truly to be made, we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, representatives, successors and assigns, firmly by these presents:

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, THAT, WHEREAS, the above named Principal desires to engage in the house moving business in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and desires to apply to the Permits Center of the City of Tulsa for a House Mover's License and permits to move houses from one location to another in the City of Tulsa, all as provided by law and the Ordinances of the City of Tulsa relating to the moving of buildings or structures and to the use of obstruction of the streets, highways and other places of the City, and particularly, Title 51, Tulsa Revised Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said license and permits are granted and if the said Principal shall exercise any privilege under said permits to do any work contemplated under said ordinances and shall pay any and all damages which may occur to any pavement, street, sidewalk or to any City fire or police, telephone or telegraph system, or any other public property of said City, or to any viaduct, or to any private property, whether such damage shall be caused by the said Principal or his agents, servants, employees, workmen or subcontractors, and shall save and indemnify and keep harmless the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, against any and all liabilities, judgments, damages, costs and expenses which may in any wise occur against said City in consequence of the granting of such permits to said principal, agents, employees, servants, workmen or subcontractors, while acting under the same, and particularly Title 51, Tulsa Revised Ordinances, and shall comply in all respects with the Ordinances of the City relating to the use or obstruction of the streets, highways and other places of said City, and shall save, indemnify and protect the City of Tulsa, and/or any private person or corporation residing within the municipal limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, from all loss or damage which may arise or be occasioned either directly or indirectly from the moving of any building or structure by said principal, his agents, servants, employees, workmen or subcontractors while engaged in any work in connection with the moving of any building or structure, including any loss or damages which may be sustained because of the stoppage of any business or industry located along the route which said building or structure shall be moved, caused or occasioned by the operation of moving such building or structure, then and in that event, this obligation shall be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect so long as any rights are exercised under the permits herein mentioned.

THIS BOND shall be for the benefit of the City of Tulsa and any private person or corporation sustaining damages under the conditions hereof; and any such private person or corporation shall be entitled to sue hereon in his or its own name.

THIS BOND shall expire June 30, _____; provided, however, causes, action or claims arising hereunder shall not be barred from the obligation of this bond except as by law provided.
